### **MILDRED CABAN IS APPOINTED TO THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT IN PONCE, PUERTO RICO**

BOSTON (March 31, 2010) — Chief Judge Sandra L. Lynch of the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit announced today that on March 19, 2010, Judge Mildred Cabán was sworn in as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Puerto Rico. Judge Cabán will sit in Ponce, Puerto Rico and Judge Brian Tester will now sit permanently in San Juan, Puerto Rico.

Judge Cabán graduated from New York University School of Law, receiving her J.D. degree in 1986. She also holds a bachelor's degree from Barnard College, New York. Judge Cabán was a partner at the firm of Goldman Antonetti & Córdova, P.S.C., where her practice focused on bankruptcy and creditors' rights. She has a wealth of experience handling a large number of complicated bankruptcy matters involving tax, labor, environmental and corporate issues. Judge Cabán has been active in various organizations, including the American Bankruptcy Institute and the Puerto Rico Bankruptcy Bar Association. At the start of her career in Puerto Rico, Judge Cabán was a law clerk to the Honorable Héctor Laffitte of the District of Puerto Rico.
