REPORT ON LOSS MITIGATION STATISTICS

THE SIXTH YEAR – (Updated through July 31, 2015)

NOVEMBER 1, 2014 – JULY 31, 2015

From November 1, 2014 through July 31, 2015 there were 1954 bankruptcy cases filed and a total of 130 requests for loss mitigation filed. This represents approximately 7% of the filing caseload.

1. Statistics related to Loss Mitigation Requests (November 1, 2014 – April 30, 2015)

2. Statistics related to Granting, Denial, Withdrawal, Termination or Successful Loan Modification (November 1, 2014 – July 31, 2015)

Based on the above statistics, of the 57 Loss Mitigation Requests that have completed the loss mitigation mediation process, **46 requests were denied, withdrawn, terminated, vacated or dismissed (81%), compared with 11 requests (19%) resulting in a successful loan modification.** Together, these 57 cases represent 44% of the total loss mitigation requests filed during the sixth year of the program.

Of the **11 loan modifications** filed to date, **1 agreement shows a reduction of principal in excess of \$50,000.** More specifically, this agreement reduced the principal amount by **approximately \$221,957.82.** This agreement represents 9% of the total loan modification agreements filed during the sixth year of the loss mitigation program.

3. Statistics related to the Length of the Loss Mitigation Process ((November 1, 2014 – July 31, 2015) – see attached Chart.


During the sixth year of the Loss Mitigation Program, the average time frame from filing a loss mitigation request to the completion of a successful loan modification is approximately 6.4 months. The shortest time frame has been 4.7 months, and the longest thus far has been approximately 8.4 months. See figures below and attached charts.

4. Statistics related to Trial Loan Modifications ((November 1, 2014 – July 31, 2015) – see attached Chart.


There have been 30 trial modification agreements entered into during the sixth year of the loss mitigation program. Of the 30 trial modifications, 7 entered into a permanent loan modification and 3 were terminated or vacated. There are 20 loss mitigation requests still pending in a trial modification period.
