**ORDER REQUIRING BANKRUPTCY PAPERS IN THE DISTRICT OF RHODE  
ISLAND TO BE FILED ELECTRONICALLY AS OF JANUARY 1, 2007\***

In April 2003, this Court implemented the national electronic case filing system known as CM/ECF, and in October 2003, made the electronic filing component of the system available to attorneys and other participants on a voluntary basis. On November 3, 2004, the Court issued General Order 04-003 requiring certain classes of filers to file their papers with the Court electronically.

To facilitate this Court's movement to full electronic filing of bankruptcy cases and papers in Rhode Island, it is hereby **ORDERED** that effective January 1, 2007, all papers shall be filed and served electronically as required by the 9<sup>th</sup> Amended Administrative General Order Establishing Procedures for Filing, Signing, Maintaining, and Verifying Pleadings and Other Documents in the Electronic Case Filing (ECF) System (AO 06-002), unless exemptions are granted as specified under AO 06-002, Administrative Procedures Section I, sub-section E.
