Whereas, on April 20, 2005 the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the Act) was enacted into law; and

Whereas, most provisions of the Act became effective on October 17, 2005; and

Whereas, on October 17, 2005, this Court entered General Order 05-004 adopting the Interim Federal Rules designed to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Act; and

Whereas, on September 19, 2006, the Judicial Conference subsequently approved amendments to Interim Rule 1007; and

Whereas, the general effective date of the Act has not provided sufficient time to promulgate rules after appropriate public notice and an opportunity for comment.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and U.S. District Court for the District of Rhode Island General Local Rule 109(h)(1) Authorizing Promulgation of Local Bankruptcy Rules, amended Interim Rule 1007 is adopted in its entirety, effective October 1, 2006.

For cases and proceedings not governed by the Act, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, other than the Interim Federal Rules, shall continue to apply.

In addition, to conform this Court's local rules with the recent national rule and form

changes, amendments to Interim Local Rules 1007 and 4008 are also hereby adopted effective October 1, 2006.

Interim Federal Rule 1007, and Interim Local Rules 1007 and 4008, as amended, shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.

This order is effective October 1, 2006.
