NOTICE OF CHANGE IN LOCAL RULE 1007-1(b)(2) AND CLERK'S OFFICE PROCEDURE FOR ELECTRONIC FILING OF STATEMENT OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER(S) (OFFICIAL FORM B21)

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 1, 2013

COURT FILERS PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: Effective October 1, 2013, the Clerk's office

will follow amended Local Rule 1007-1(b)(2) in its deadline and review procedures for the

filing of the debtors Statement of Social Security Number(s) (Official Form B21).

Attorneys electronically filing new bankruptcy petitions will now be required to file the

Statement of Social Security Number(s) (Official Form B21) as a separate private event in

ECF immediately upon completion of the filing of the petition. Failure to file the Statement of

Social Security will result in the issuance of a 7 Day Missing Documents Notice and Notice of

Automatic Dismissal for Non-Compliance.

FILING INSTRUCTIONS

After the bankruptcy petition is filed, the **Statement of Social Security Number(s)** (Official Form B21) must be filed using the *private* event, "Statement of Social Security Number(s) (Official Form B21)". This private event ensures that only court personnel have access to the

debtor's full social security number.

Amended B21 Statements should be filed using the *private event*, **AMENDED Statement of Social Security Number(s) (Official Form B21).**

In accordance with Fed.R.Bank.P. 9037 and Local Rule 9037-1, filers should ensure that they do **NOT** attach the **Statement of Social Security Number(s)** (**Official Form B21**) to the voluntary petition or any schedules.

The filing attorney should continue to retain the original **Statement of Social Security Number(s) (Official Form B21)** for the prescribed period of time pursuant to LBR 5005-4.
