ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY VINCENT ODDO LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under AO 06-002, Administrative Procedures Section I, sub-section E. Thereafter, on January 17, 2007, Attorney Vincent J. Oddo filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: Rebud Inc., Bk. No. 07-10076, and In re: Michael T. Teixeira, BK.No. 07-10077, stating as grounds that, other than these two cases, he does not plan on representing any new debtors before the Bankruptcy Court, and that to require him to become an electronic filer would create an undue hardship.

Accordingly, based upon Mr. Oddo's representation that he will not file any new cases or documents in this Court upon the completion of the above two cases, his Motions for Exemption are **GRANTED** with respect to cases 07-10076 and 07-10077 and Vincent J. Oddo Esq. may continue to conventionally file all papers necessary to complete the administration of these two cases.
