ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY HARRY ROLL LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on May 10, 2007, Harry Roll Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: Zoraida McEvoy, BK. No. 07-10716, stating as grounds that he does not plan on representing any new parties before the Bankruptcy Court, and that as a sole practitioner to require him to become an electronic filer would create an undue hardship.

Accordingly, based upon Attorney Harry Roll's representation that he will not file any new cases in this Court upon the completion of the above case, his Motion for Exemption is **GRANTED** with respect to case 07-10716, and Harry Roll Esq. may continue to conventionally file all papers necessary to complete the administration of this case. If Mr. Roll elects to file documents in any other current pending or new cases in the Court, he will need to become an electronic user.
