**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY DENNIS E. MCMAHON LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. On April 27, 2007, in the bankruptcy case of Concert Club Inc., BK No. 07-10180, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause against Dennis McMahon Esq., why certain documents should not be stricken and/or sanctions imposed for failure to comply with the Court's order requiring that all pleadings be filed electronically. Thereafter, on May 8, 2007, Attorney McMahon filed a response to the order to show cause through Attorney Laurel E. Bretta.


Upon consideration of the response and based upon Attorney McMahon's representations, a limited exemption is **GRANTED** with respect to case 07-10180. Attorney McMahon may continue to conventionally file all papers necessary to complete the administration of this case; however, Attorney Bretta shall not file any documents electronically on behalf of Attorney McMahon.
