## ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY MICHAEL A. KELLY LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I.
