**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY KEVIN McBURNEY A PERMANENT
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING IN BANKRUPTCY CASE 10-11070**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on April 15, 2010, Kevin McBurney, Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: Steven H. DeAngelis 10-11070 stating as grounds that, other than representing his client on a pro bono basis who has been a lifelong friend, he does not intend on practicing before the Bankruptcy Court.

Accordingly, based upon Attorney Kevin McBurney's representation that he will not file any new cases or documents in this Court upon the completion of the above case, his Motion for Exemption is **GRANTED**, and Attorney Kevin McBurney may continue to file all papers conventionally in bankruptcy case 10-11070.

If Attorney Kevin McBurney subsequently files any new bankruptcy cases or enters an appearance in any other pending cases in this district, the Court may reconsider this Exemption Order and require said attorney to become a registered Electronic Filer with the Court.
