ORDER BARRING ATTORNEY DAVID PLANTE FROM FUTURE FILINGS FOR FAILURE TO BECOME AN ELECTRONIC FILER IN ACCORDANCE WITH LBR 5005-4

On December 23, 2009, the Court issued a notice [doc. no. 14] requiring that Attorney David Plante take the necessary steps to become a registered CM/ECF user, or seek an exemption from electronic filing within twenty days, in accordance with LBR 5005-4(c)(2). No action was taken by Attorney David Plante to the Court's notice.

Thereafter, on February 5, 2010, an Order to Show Cause was issued [doc. no. 24] why any future document(s) filed by Attorney David Plante should not be accepted unless electronically filed by the court, with a 14-day response deadline. To date, now more than 14 days past the deadline, Attorney David Plante has failed to respond in any way to this Court's order to show cause.

Therefore, due to counsel's complete disregard for our Order to Show Cause, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Attorney David Plante is BARRED from conventionally filing any documents with the Court, and the Clerk is hereby instructed to refuse all such conventional filings. Counsel may file any future documents with the Court by becoming an electronic filer.
