## ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY THOMAS M. PETRONIO LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. On November 21, 2007, in the bankruptcy case of Concert Club Inc., BK No. 07-10180, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause against Thomas M. The Court will not accept any future filings from Attorney Petronio in any other case, unless he becomes a registered user.
