ORDER DISMISSING CASE WITH 180 DAY BAR TO RE-FILING AND PROHIBITING ANY FUTURE FILING WITHOUT PRIOR COURT APPROVAL

On May 2, 2003, this Court issued an Order to Show Cause against the Debtors ordering them to appear and show cause why the above captioned bankruptcy case should not be dismissed as an abuse of the bankruptcy process. The Order to Show Cause was set for hearing on May 6, 2003, and continued to June 3, 2003. This case is the Debtors' fifth Chapter 13 filing since January 3, 2001. For the reasons set forth in the Order to Show Cause and stated on the record at the conclusion of the June 3, 2003 hearing, I find that cause has not been shown and the above captioned bankruptcy case is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE. The Debtors are barred for a period of 180 days from filing any further bankruptcy petitions. Additionally, the Debtors are prohibited from filing any future bankruptcy petition in this District without first obtaining the Court's permission by motion seeking the authorization to file a new petition.
