REPORT ON LOSS MITIGATION STATISTICS

THE FIFTH YEAR – (Updated through April 30, 2015)

NOVEMBER 1, 2013 – OCTOBER 31, 2014

From November 1, 2013 through October 31, 2014 there were 2,954 bankruptcy cases filed and a total of 206 requests for loss mitigation filed. This represents approximately 7% of the filing caseload.

1. Statistics related to Loss Mitigation Requests (November 1, 2013 – October 31, 2014)

2. Statistics related to Granting, Denial, Withdrawal, Termination or Successful Loan Modification (November 1, 2013 – October 31, 2014)

Based on the above statistics, of the 153 Loss Mitigation Requests that have completed the loss mitigation mediation process, **79 requests were denied, withdrawn, terminated, vacated or dismissed (52%), compared with 74 requests (48%) resulting in a successful loan modification.** Together, these 153 cases represent 74% of the total loss mitigation requests filed during the fifth year of the program.

Of the **74 loan modifications** filed to date, **3 agreements show a reduction of principal in excess of \$50,000**, with the highest reduction being approximately \$139,000.00. This represents 4% of the total loan modification agreements filed during the fourth year of the loss mitigation program.

3. Statistics related to the Length of the Loss Mitigation Process (November 1, 2013 – October 31, 2014) – see attached Chart.


During the fifth year of the Loss Mitigation Program, the average time frame from filing a loss mitigation request to the completion of a successful loan modification is approximately 7.6 months. The shortest time frame has been 2 months, and the longest thus far has been approximately 15.4 months. See figures below and attached charts.

4. Statistics related to Trial Loan Modifications (November 1, 2013 – October 31, 2014) – see attached Chart.


There have been 71 trial modification agreements entered into during the fifth year of the loss mitigation program. Of the 71 trial modifications, 41 entered into a permanent loan modification and 4 were terminated or vacated. There are 26 loss mitigation requests still pending in a trial modification period.
