

**LOCAL RULE 9010-1 ATTORNEYS ADMISSION TO PRACTICE, REPRESENTATION
AND APPEARANCES [Amended ~~10/1/13~~ 6/3/2025]**

(a) Admission to Practice. An attorney who is in good standing of the bar of the Supreme Court of Rhode Island and is admitted to practice in the United States District Court for the District of Rhode Island shall be deemed admitted to practice in this Court.

...

(f) Attorneys for the United States. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), an attorney who is a member in good standing of the bar of another federal district court and each jurisdiction in which that attorney has been admitted to practice may appear and practice in this Court as an attorney for the United States or for any agency of the United States or for an officer of the United States in his or her official capacity.
