NOTICE REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS

EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2019

On April 1, 2019, automatic adjustments will be made to the dollar amounts stated in various provisions of the Bankruptcy Code and one provision of Title 28. Seven Official Bankruptcy Forms (106C, 107, 122A-2, 122C-2, 201, 207, and 410) will be amended to reflect these adjusted dollar amounts. The adjustments will apply to cases filed on or after April 1, 2019.

If the correct official form is not used beginning on April 1, 2019, the court will issue a Notice of Missing/Defective Document, noting the incorrect form. If the correct official form is not filed within fourteen days from the date of the applicable notice, the court may strike the pleading or dismiss the case.
