## Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019

Why? On August 23, 2019, the President signed H.R. 3311, the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019, Pub. L. No. 116-54, into law. The Small Business Reorganization Act (SBRA), which takes effect on February 19, 2020, amends title 11 of the United States Code to create a new subchapter V to chapter 11 for the reorganization of small business debtors. It does not repeal existing chapter 11 provisions regarding small business debtors, but instead creates an alternative procedure that

This training will address the new subchapter V Bankruptcy Code provisions, as well as this district's implementation plans including interim local rules and forms, new electronic filing events, local deadlines and procedures, US Trustee process and attorney best practices and recommendations for handling cases filed under subchapter V of chapter 11.
