

Providing access to justice and service to the public is one of the key issues highlighted by the Court's Strategic Plan. The District of Rhode Island has adopted a number of programs aimed at expanding outreach, improving access to bankruptcy services, and informing the public of the Court's rules and procedures.

The <u>Rhode Island Bankruptcy Legal Clinic</u> ("the Clinic") is a free legal clinic that is a partnership between the RI Bankruptcy Court and various members of the Rhode Island bankruptcy legal community. This program provides the public with an opportunity to speak via telephone

with a volunteer bankruptcy attorney for a free half-hour consultation. The Clinic provides limited legal advice to individuals without an attorney by answering their questions about bankruptcy and required paperwork, as well as how bankruptcy may be used to help prevent foreclosure.



The Electronic Drop Box (EDB) is a tool available to selfrepresented litigants that enables them to upload court documents for filing electronically in bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings pending in this District. There were a total of 44 users since implementation in 2020.

About Pre-Filing Bankruptcy Counseling

Under federal law, you are *required* to obtain credit counseling from a qualified non-profit agency before filing for bankruptcy. Failure to do so may result in the dismissal of your case, loss of filing fees and limitations on re-filing or applicability of the automatic stay.



Free or Low Cost Legal Assistance

Bankruptcy filers without attorney representation are at a much higher risk of having document filing deficiencies result in a dismissal of their case. In Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court, 74% of self-represented debtors had their cases dismissed, while only 6.0% of represented debtors received dismissals.
