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**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY DONALD NASIF
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On November 3, 2004, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 04-003 requiring electronic case filing by attorneys/firms filing twenty five (25) or more Chapter 7, 11, and 13 bankruptcy petitions; or twenty five (25) or more motions for relief from stay; and/or Adversary proceedings in a given twelve month period (beginning 11/1/03-10/31/04) . Thereafter, on September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring *all* papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under AO 06-002, Administrative Procedures Section I, sub-section E.

Since the issuance of G.O. 04-003 and G.O. 06-003, Attorney Donald Nasif has voluntarily participated in three different Court-sponsored CM/ECF training courses. After experiencing continued difficulties, on July 15, 2005, Attorney Donald Nasif filed a request that he be “decertified” as an electronic filer and be allowed to file papers conventionally.

Accordingly, based upon Mr. Nasif’s prior representations he is **GRANTED** an exemption from electronic filing under AO 06-002, Administrative Procedures Section I, sub-section E, and may continue to conventionally file all papers.
