**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY ANDREW J. MCKAY LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. On May 2, 2007, in the bankruptcy case of Kevin M. Campopiano, BK No. 07-10283, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause against Andrew J. McKay Esq., why certain documents should not be stricken and/or sanctions imposed for failure to comply with the Court's order requiring that all pleadings be filed electronically. Thereafter, on May 29, 2007, Attorney McKay filed a Request for Exemption from Electronic Filing.

Upon consideration of the request, and based upon Attorney McKay's representations, a limited exemption is **GRANTED** with respect to case 07-10283. The Court will not accept any future filings from Attorney McKay in any other case, unless he becomes a registered user.
