**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY GERRICK VAN DEUSEN A LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on May 2, 2008, Gerrick Van Deusen Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: 08-1006 Johnson v. Domestic Bank and PCRL Realty Co. Ltd., stating as grounds that, other than this case, he does not plan on representing any new parties before the Bankruptcy Court.


Accordingly, based upon Gerrick Van Deusen's representation that he will not file any new cases or documents in this Court upon the completion of the above case, his Motion for Exemption is **GRANTED** with respect to case A.P. 08-1006 Johnson v. Domestic Bank and PCRL Realty Co. Ltd. and Gerrick Van Deusen Esq. may continue to conventionally file all papers necessary to complete the administration of this case.
