**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY DONNA DI DONATO ESQ A LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on May 18, 2009, Donna M. Di Donato Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: 08-12736 Felice and Celeste DeQuattro, stating as grounds that, other than representing her clients in the personal injury action, she does not plan on representing any new parties before the Bankruptcy Court.
