ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY DONALD R. LEMBO A LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4, "[a]ll cases filed after April 24, 2003 are part of the Court's Case Management/Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) System. Commencing on January 1, 2007, all petitions, motions, memoranda of law, or other pleadings and documents must be electronically filed except as expressly provided in section (c) ..., or in circumstances where the Electronic Filer is prevented from filing electronically, i.e., CM/ECF System failure."

On May 2, 2019, Attorney Donald R. Lembo filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in bankruptcy case number 18-11967, *In re Brenda L. Charpentier*. Attorney Lembo indicates that he is semi-retired, he presently has no other matters pending with the U.S. Bankruptcy Court nor does he anticipate participating in any additional matters before this Court. Attorney Lembo has indicated his representation of Creditor, David Pardi in the above-referenced bankruptcy matter is limited and relates to only one issue. Attorney Lembo does not intend to file any further pleadings or represent any other parties before the Bankruptcy Court.

Accordingly, based upon Attorney Lembo's statement, his Motion for a Limited Exemption is **GRANTED.** Attorney Lembo may continue to conventionally file in the above-referenced case if necessary. Should Attorney Donald R. Lembo later file a pleading in any other case before this Court, the limited exemption issued herein will not apply and said Attorney will be required to become a registered Electronic Filer with the Court at that time.
