**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY SCOTT J. PARTINGTON LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on November 8, 2007, Scott J. Partington Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: McGuinness v. Sousa, AP. No. 07-1046, stating as grounds that, other than this case, he does not plan on representing any new parties before the Bankruptcy Court.


