**ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY TRICIA QUEST LIMITED
EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING**

On September 14, 2006, the Rhode Island Bankruptcy Court issued G.O. 06-003 requiring all papers be filed and served electronically, effective January 1, 2007, unless an exemption is granted as specified under R.I. Local Rule 5005-4 Electronic Filing. Thereafter, on April 23, 2007, Tricia Quest Esq. filed a Motion for Exemption from Electronic Filing in, In re: Gonzalez v. Tavaras, AP. No. 06-1074, stating as grounds that, other than this case, she does not plan on representing any new parties before the Bankruptcy Court, and that to require her to become an electronic filer would create an undue hardship.


Accordingly, based upon Tricia Quest's representation that she will not file any new cases or documents in this Court upon the completion of the above case, her Motions for Exemption is **GRANTED** with respect to case 06-1074 and Tricia Quest Esq. may continue to conventionally file all papers necessary to complete the administration of this case.
